

RESOLUTION.

A Resolution fixing maximum salaries and wages which may be paid by the City Manager of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and repealing Resolution No. 520.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:


1. That the City Manager of said City of Lexington is hereby authorized to pay maximum salaries not exceeding the respective amounts as hereinafter set forth:

Department head, including fire chief, police chief and office manager	\$300.00
Police Officers	\$225.00
Labor Foremen (Salary)	\$225.00
Machine Operator	\$250.00
Electric Line Foreman	275. 250. \$275.00
Lineman	250. 250. \$250.00
Pump Attendants	\$150.00
Librarian	\$125.00
Labor Foreman (wages)	95¢ per hr.
Laborers "	85¢ per hr.
Custodian	\$150.00
Bookkeeper	\$200.00
Stenographer-clerk	\$150.00
Meter reader	\$250.00
Utility Engineer	\$300.00

That the maximum salaries as herein provided are not intended to cover all employees or bring all employees up to the maximum level but are established as a maximum amount which may be paid to permit necessary adjustments based upon qualification and ability of the respective employees.


2. That Resolution No. 520 which was passed and approved by the Council of said City on November 23, 1948, be and the same is hereby repealed.
