

RESOLUTION

"BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:


1. This council finds and certifies that the Treasurer of the City of Lexington has presented to this Council in open session Electric Light Revenue Refunding Bonds of the aggregate principal amount of One Hundred fifty-six Thousand Dollars (\$156,000), dated March 1, 1949 consisting of 156 bonds of \$1,000 each, numbered serially from 21 to 176, inclusive, together with all interest coupons appertaining to said bonds, maturing March 1, 1950 and later, which bonds have been paid and retired by the issuance of Electric Revenue Refunding Bonds of this City and each and every of said bonds so redeemed and paid off and all coupons appertaining thereto have stamped or written in ink across the face of same the word "cancelled".

2. This Council further finds and enters of record that all of said bonds and coupons above referred to which have been so redeemed and cancelled have been destroyed in the presence of this Council in open meeting on this date and the record of such cancellation and destruction is hereby made."
