

R E S O L U T I O N

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, DISAVOWING THE POSITION OF THE LEAGUE OF MUNICIPALITIES IN PETITIONING THE U. S. DISTRICT COURT FOR REAPPORTIONMENT OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEBRASKA.

WHEREAS, the Nebraska League of Municipalities on the 20th day of July, 1962, filed in the United States District Court for the District of Nebraska a petition praying for the reapportionment of the Nebraska Legislature solely on the basis of population and further praying for the enjoinder of consideration by Nebraska voters of a Constitutional Amendment on the November 6, 1962, general election ballot which would give 20% to 30% weight to area in future legislature redistricting, and

WHEREAS, the League of Municipalities alleges, inter alia, that it represents a majority of the incorporated municipalities of the State of Nebraska, and

WHEREAS, the President of the City Council and the City Council of Lexington, Nebraska, are opposed to those principles manifested in the petition of the League of Municipalities and the City of Lexington, Nebraska, is a member of the League of Municipalities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE CITY COUNCIL AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

THAT the City Council of Lexington, Nebraska, disavows, repudiates and condemns the action taken by the officers of the Nebraska League of Municipalities in filing the petition aforesaid.
