

RESOLUTION NO. R1678


WHEREAS, because of growth in the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, and projected increased traffic on the main line of the Union Pacific Railroad the City Council finds that Railroad Grade Crossings will become increasingly hazardous; and

WHEREAS, for the safety of persons using streets in the City of Lexington it is desirable that planning be commenced for a second Railroad overpass in the City of Lexington.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:


1. That the Lexington City Council hereby goes on record in favor of the concept of a second Railroad overpass within the City of Lexington.
2. That the City administration is directed and authorized to make application to the State of Nebraska for funding to complete a feasibility study as preparation for possible construction of a second railroad overpass within the City of Lexington.
